Nancy Malo began her medical career as a respiratory therapist yet felt truly called by God to provide better instruction to families and couples around Natural Family Planning. She became Catholic Medical Center's Natural Family Planning Instructor in 1983.

For 37 years, Nancy worked tirelessly to educate on the loving values of Catholic healthcare and embodied what is truly meant by protecting the dignity of every human person. Believing in the mission of her Catholic values, Nancy advocated for years to bring an approach to women's reproductive health that uses natural methods and restorative surgery to treat conditions. This has become the cornerstone of establishing the Women's Wellness & Fertility Center at CMC. It is the only such practice in New England. This unique practice just celebrated its 5th anniversary.



In 2022, Nancy received the Saint Martin dePorres award, an annual award presented by the NH Guild of Catholic Health Professionals and Bishop Peter Libasci to an individual who has exemplified the virtues of Catholic healthcare in her or his career. In honor of her years of dedicated service, and her continued involvement as a part-time employee, CMC is proud to establish the *Nancy Malo Scholarship Fund for Natural Family Planning Education*.
