The Parish Nurse provides a number of key healthcare and support roles to clients including:

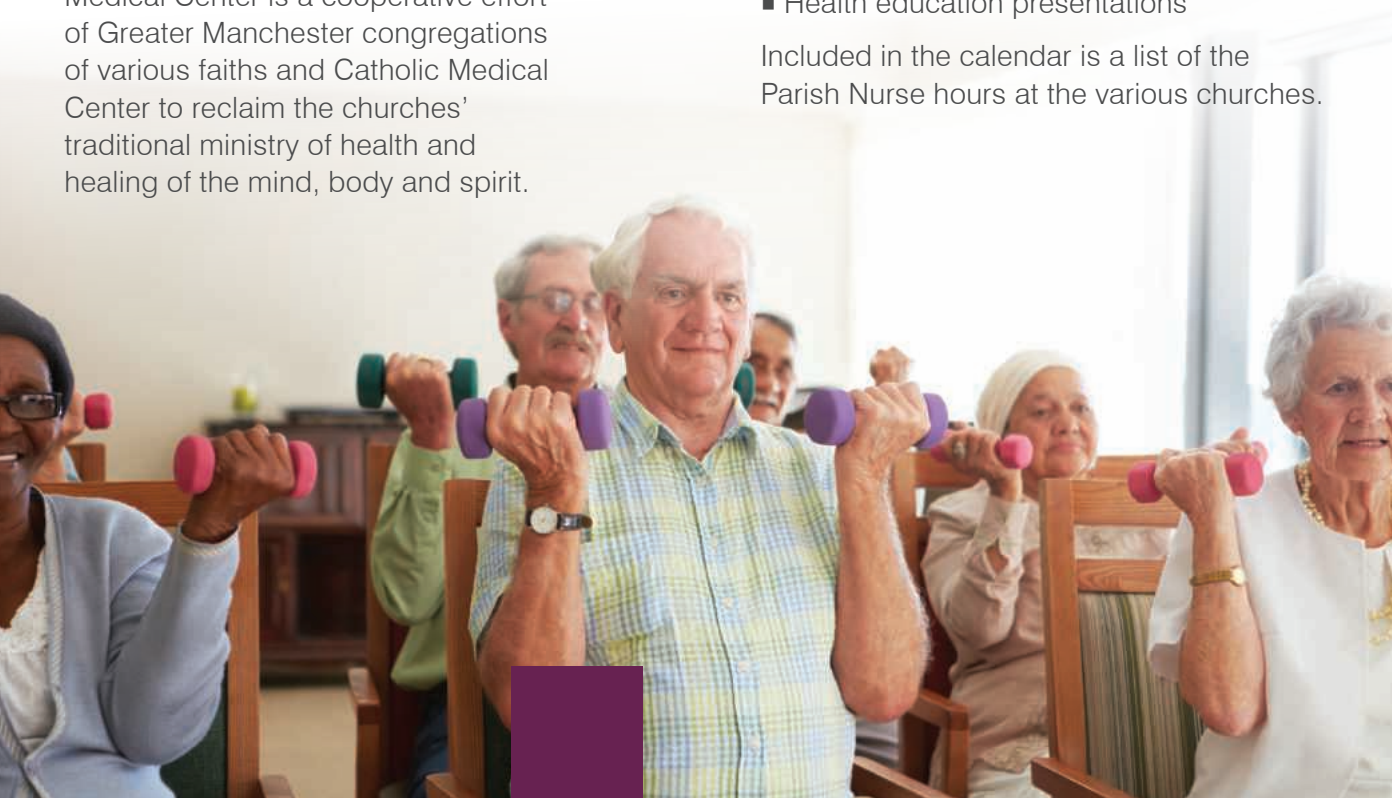
- Health Counseling
